BASTILLE

A CELEBRATION OF FREEDOM

For the past 17 years, the Franschhoek Valley has hosted a Bastille Festival as close as possible to 14th July, Bastille Day in France and the anniversary of the storming of the prison fortress known as La Bastille. This event was later seen by historians as the turning point in French history and the beginning of the French Revolution, which led to the liberation of France from a corrupt monarchy and the establishment of freedom and democracy. Again in 2010, Franschhoek's Bastille Festival, which began as village fête, will be a celebration of freedom for all!

The mountains that encompass the beautiful Franschhoek Wine Valley echo and bear witness to the yearning to be free of men and women everywhere across the centuries. This is the valley in which French Huguenots sought refuge from religious persecution and in which newly liberated slaves established the village of Pniel in 1834. It is also the valley in which in 1990, just over two centuries after the Storming of the Bastille, Nelson Mandela took those few short steps out of Victor Verster Prison (now Drakenstein Correctional Services) on his long walk to freedom – steps which, in their simplicity, were as significant a turning point in South African history as the Storming of the Bastille was in French history.

The Bastille Festival establishes Franschhoek as an international festival hotspot, welcoming all to be part of a true celebration of freedom. The Franschhoek Bastille Festival will include the always well-attended Food & Wine Marquee, the Marché Franschhoek in the Town Hall featuring a showcase of Franschhoek artisanal food & fare, kiddies activities, the competitive Franschhoek Bastille SPCA Boules (Petanque) Tournament, the fun of the Porcupine Ridge Barrel Rolling Competition, the Movie Festival at The Screening Room at Le Quartier Français... and lots more!
